Mostly though, my burps have been used in conjunction with a few other sounds to create new sounds in Sound Design... As for the Sarlacc Burp, I don't really know for certain, but it does sound as though it might be a slightly slowed down version of one of my "wet burps". It's only a guess however. In either case, my "official" autograph is "Jabba's Burp" although in a couple of cases I have signed "Elliot's Burp" for E.T. Fans.

In "real life", I've been retired from Skywalker Sound since 2011... My current work is as a driver for <u>https://aclima.io/</u> where I drive a cute little 2019 Prius around all night long, sampling the air quality in the San Francisco Bay Area... We sell the air quality data to interested agencies.
